


Fig. 1. Continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature




Fig. 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature





Fig. 3. Single pulse avalanche rating; avalanche current as a function of avalanche time

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
Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage




Fig. 6. Output characteristics; drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

 $T_j=25^{\circ}C$




Fig. 7. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; I_D = 5A$$




Fig. 8. Forward transconductance as a function of drain current; typical values

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; \ V_{DS} = 10V$$




Fig. 10. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; \ V_{DS} = 5V$$




Fig. 9. Transfer characteristics; drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

$$V_{DS} = 10V$$




Fig. 11. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

$$V_{DS} = V_{GS}$$




Fig. 12. Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values




Fig. 14. Gate charge waveform definitions




Fig. 13. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature

$$a = \frac{R_{DSon}}{R_{DSon (25^{\circ}C)}}$$




Fig. 15. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values

$$T_j = 25^{\circ}C; I_D = 5A$$





Fig. 16. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances | Fig. 17. Source current as a function of source-drain as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values




Fig. 18. Reverse recovery timing definition




Fig. 19. Package outline LFPAK; Power-SO8 (SOT669)

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
