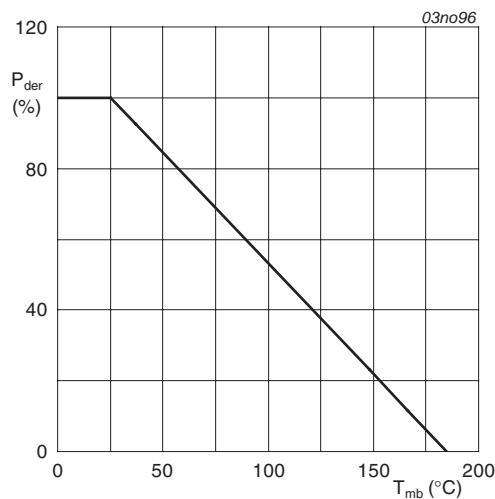

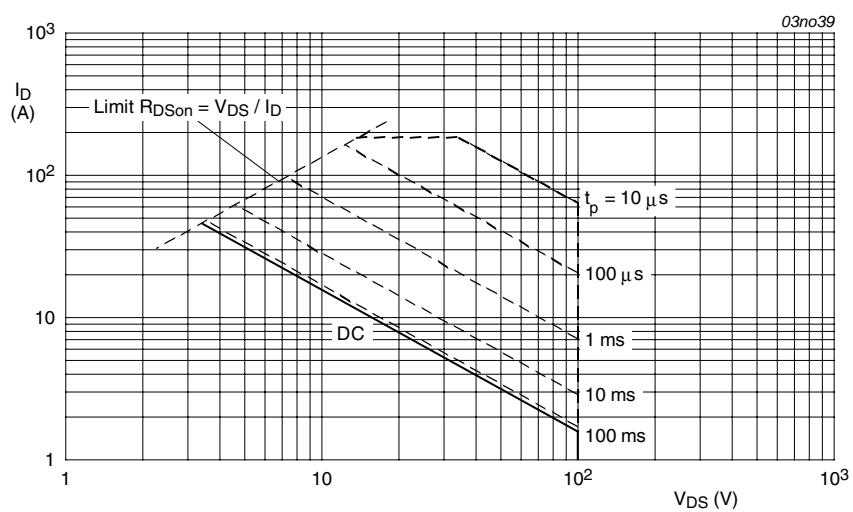

**Fig 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature**



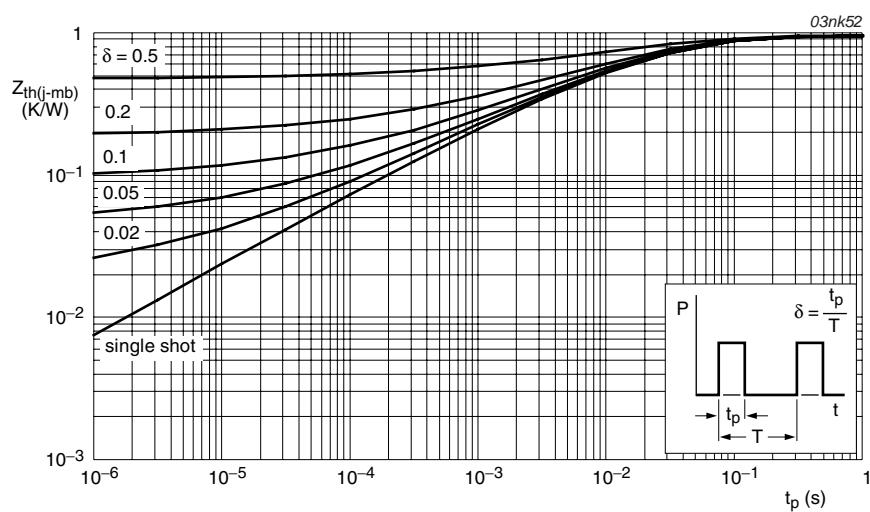

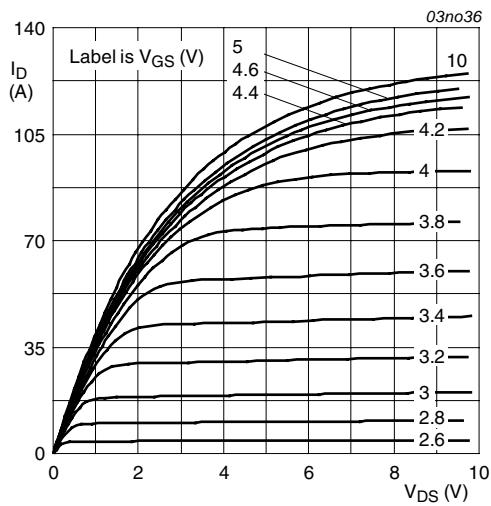


**Fig 4. Transient thermal impedance from junction to mounting base as a function of pulse duration**

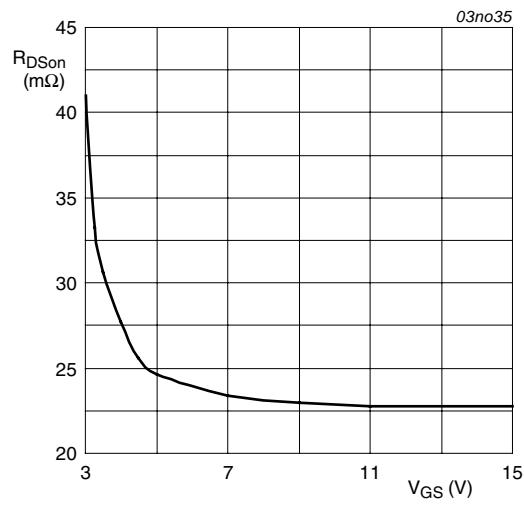

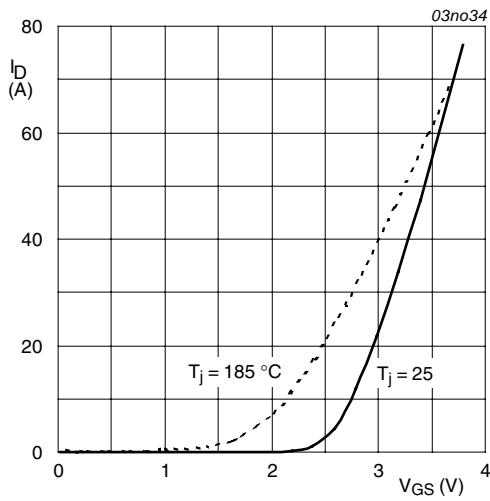

**Fig 5.** Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values



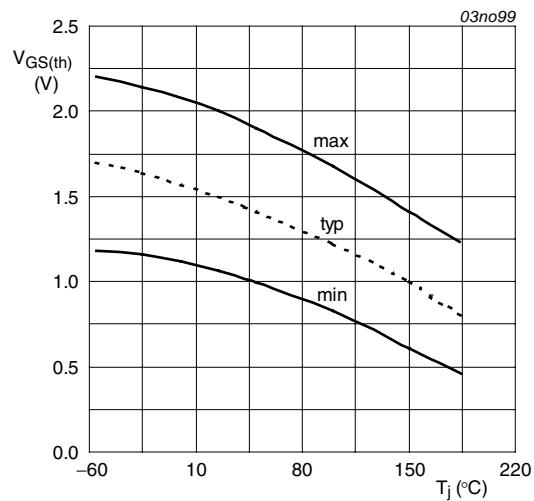

**Fig 6.** Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values



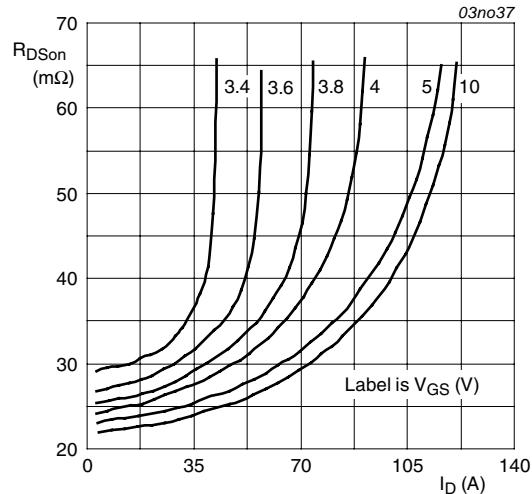

**Fig 7.** Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values



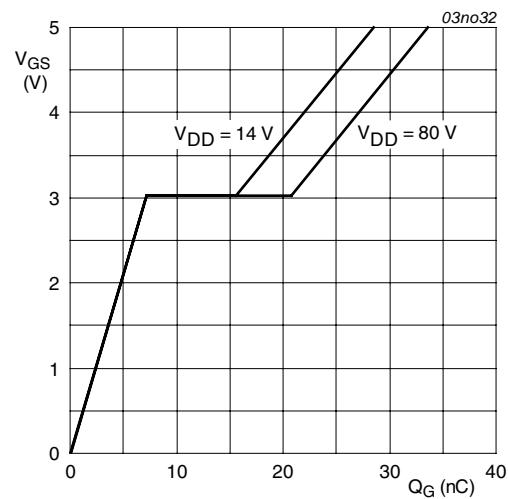

**Fig 8.** Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature



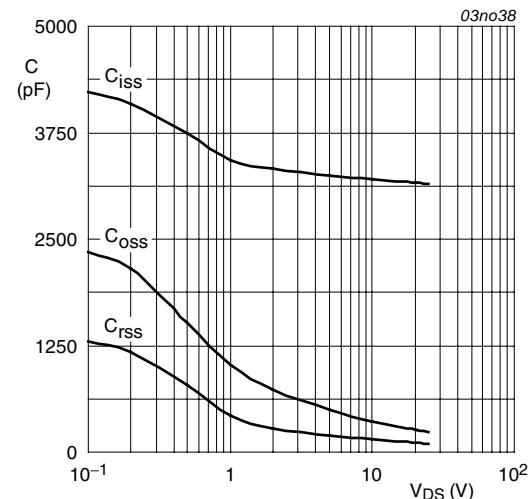

**Fig 9.** Drain-source on-state resistance as a function of drain current; typical values



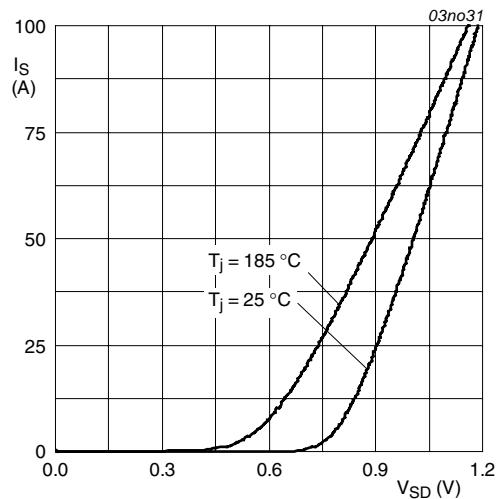

**Fig 10.** Gate-source voltage as a function of gate charge; typical values



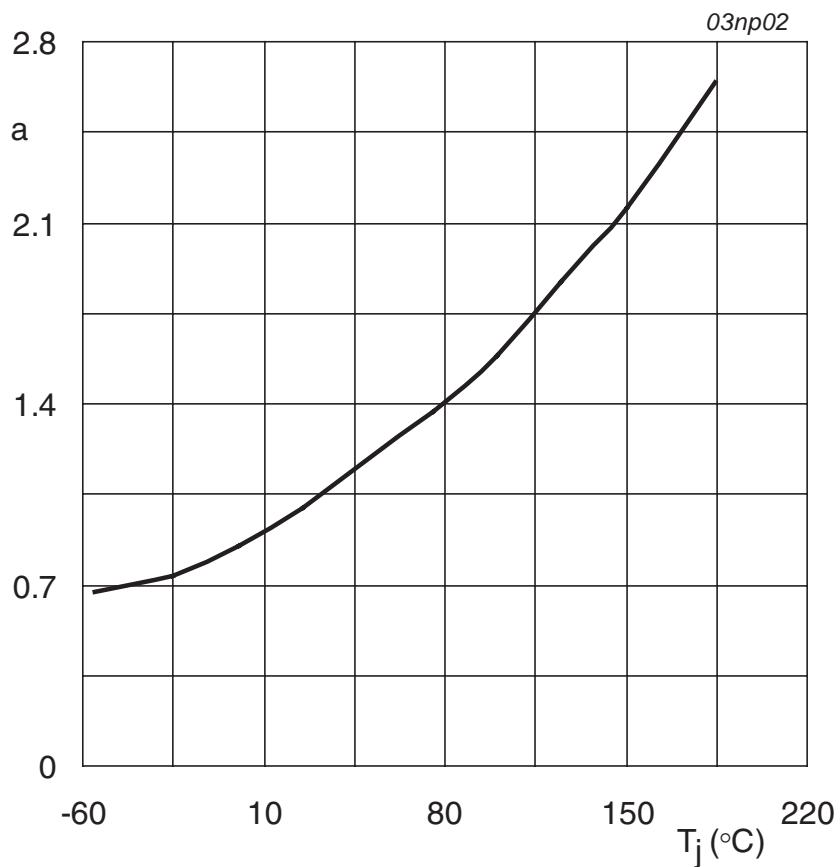

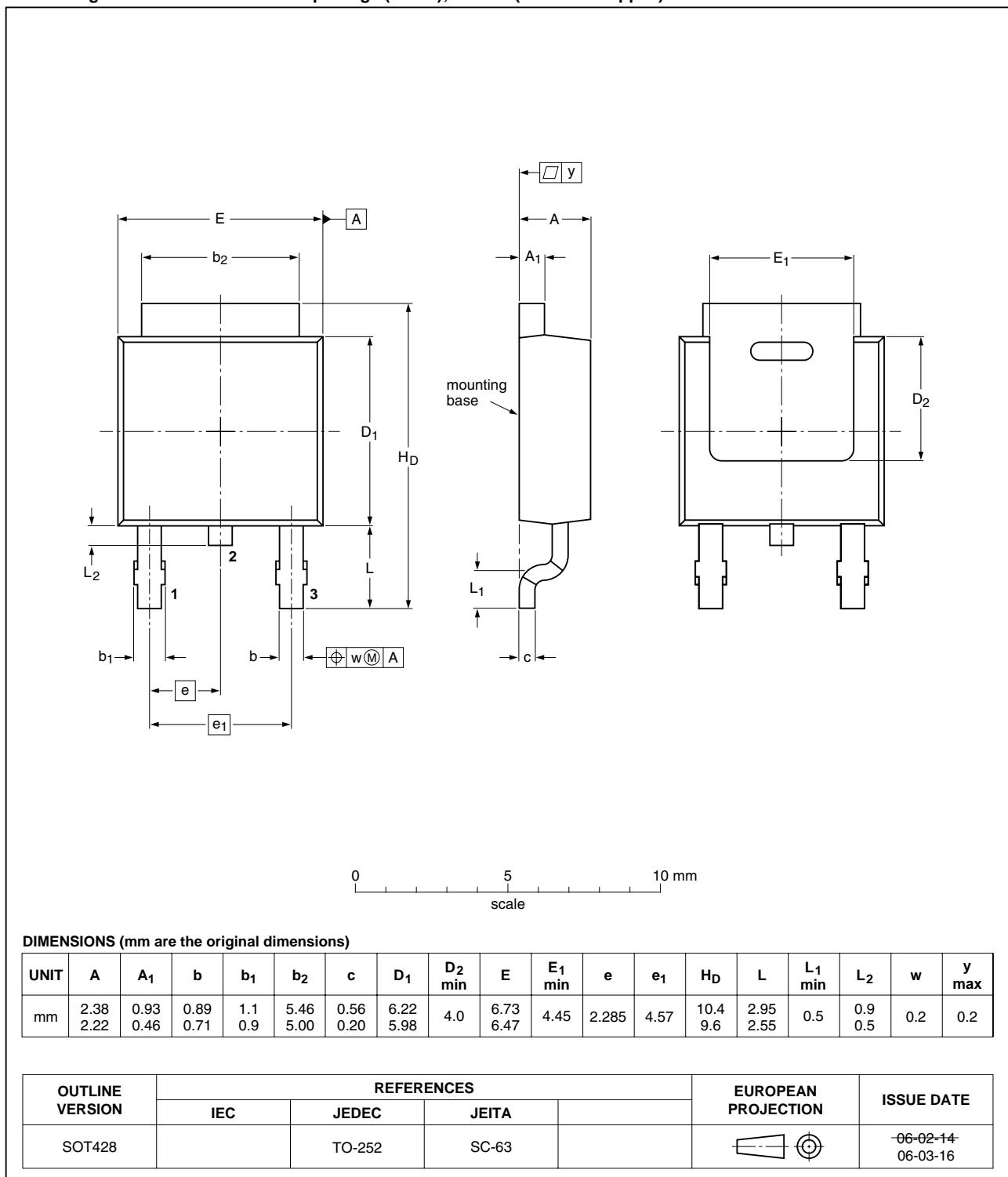


Fig 14. Package outline SOT428 (DPAK)
